

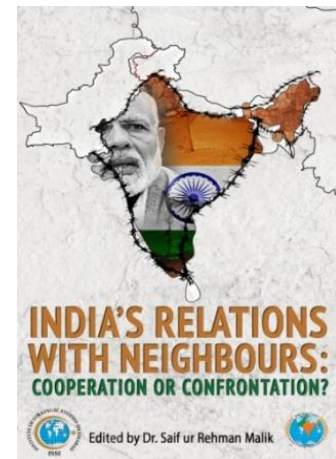


CALL FOR BOOK CHAPTERS

Scope, Aims, and Objectives

The proposed book intends to present a holistic approach towards the transforming Indian domestic politics and international outlook in the 21st Century.

Following are some of the suggested sub-themes:

- Internal political affairs/fault lines
- Modi’s Policies towards the India Illegally Occupied Jammu and Kashmir (IIOJK) post-August 2019
- Political parties and ideological strife
- Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh and Hindutva ideology
- Dissident voices, militancy, and insurgency
- Separatist movements in India

- Military industrial complex and Economy
- Situation of minorities
- Growing misogyny and the rights of women
- Non-Traditional Security threats
- Indo-China Relations

Submission Guidelines

- The last date for the submission of 300-word abstract is **January 20, 2022**. It should follow a brief intro/bio of the author. The latter be sent electronically at drsaifmalik@issi.org.pk
- The selected authors/abstracts will be contacted/notified by **January 31, 2022**.
- The complete chapter is expected by **March 31, 2022**.
- All chapters will undergo arduous peer-review and revisions back and forth.
- For referencing, all chapters must follow *Chicago Manual of Style 16th Edition* (Full note).
- The desired length of the chapter is 5,000 to 7,000 words including notes; however, the editor may solicit longer or shorter ones.
